World and Olympic 400m champion Kirani James returns to his native Grenada this week. James will arrive at the Maurice Bishop International Airport at approximately 8:00 p.m. ET on Thursday August 30. Thousands are expected to welcome the Grenadian champion on his arrival.

The celebrations continue on Saturday September 1st (his 20th birthday) with a national motorcade that will conclude with a rally at the National Stadium in St George's where the Government will announce a reward package to James, including a major surprise!
